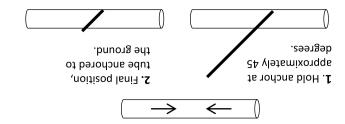

- damaged or missing fixings
- damaged nets / damaged or missing net fixings
- correct attachments of net to the goal frame

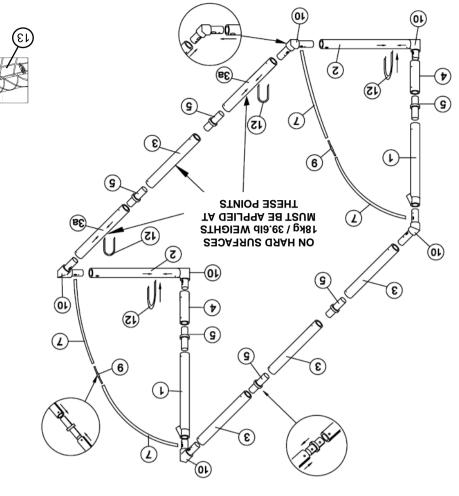
Arrows indicating anchoring points and anchors to be inserted at 45 degrees. Method of anchoring

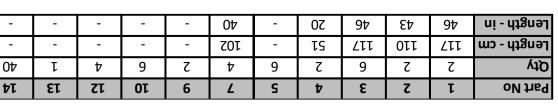

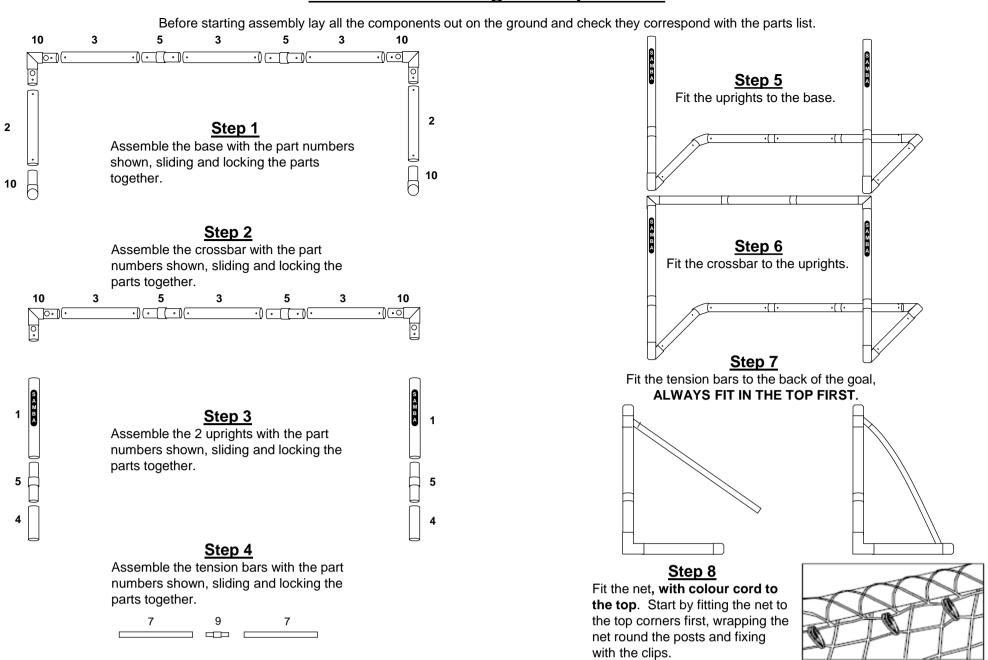

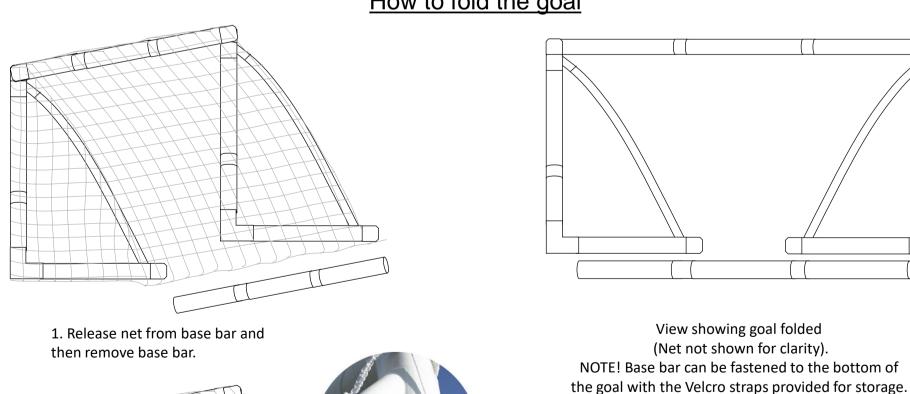


Step 9
